Celebrating "50 Years of Hope & Heroes!"

Our 50th anniversary commemoration launched with a virtual celebration on Thursday, October 28, 2021, and runs through the end of 2022. We are highlighting our services that bring hope ("esperanza") to our community, and to thank the El Proyecto staff who have heroically served the

community.



Fifty years ago, we began our journey as a small neighborhood nonprofit organization with a goal of improving access to vital services for people in need in the Northeast San Fernando Valley.

Today, we are the eighth-largest nonprofit in the San Fernando Valley and one of the 25 largest in the Los Angeles area.

We provide high quality health care, behavioral health, adult and youth employment and child development services in the San Fernando and San Gabriel Valleys as well as East Los Angeles and San Bernardino.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, El Proyecto has conducted more than 400,000 health care office visits, helped many job seekers find new positions, served hundreds of children at our Child Development Centers, and provided more than 63,000 Covid-19 vaccinations.
